Netball Qld Awards



OPERATING WITH EXCELLENCE

Strategic Plan

Another large piece of work this season has been the creation of a new strategic plan for the coming 3 years. It is based on our initial plan but with changes reflecting our desires and needs for the coming seasons. It is a working document and has goals and actions integrated beside each point.

Constitution

One of our current parents is taking on the job of rewriting our constitution in the offseason. This was a task on our previous strategic plan but is well under way now and should be adopted early in 2023. We will liaise with the MSC legal team to check it through before finalising it.



Policy and Procedures

We are in the process of composing updated Codes of Conduct as well as policies and procedures to manage any breaches of these codes. We encountered an issue with one of our players this season and found we didn't have sufficient procedures in place to deal with the issue as it wasn't an external complaint but rather one brought by the committee. This was the first time an issue such as this has been encountered. We will finalise this during the offseason and have it in place prior to registrations opening for 2023.



AGM

Our AGM is on 13th November, 2022.

As usual, we will vacate all positions and call for positions to be filled. The majority of our committee members and executive are returning to their roles so we have a stable committee.

We are looking for a correspondence secretary as our current secretary is going to focus on our socials and webpage as well as graphic design needs.

DEVELOPMENT

Netball Courts Proposal One of the recent large pieces of work that the committee has completed is the formal submission to Magpies Sporting Club for netball courts on the Magpies grounds. We are very happy to continue to work with the club and other affiliates to bring this dream to a fruition.



Preseason Planning

We are well underway in planning our preseason development for seniors as well as juniors. Information will be available to members in the coming week once venues are sourced.

Magpies Academy

Part of our development planning for 2023 is the establishment of a Magpies Academy for those committed players who want to improve their skills more than just one session a week. We are still in the early planning stages but are excited to make this happen.
